- **Grades 4th-6th:** Group pictures will be taken at 5:15 PM, followed by individual pictures of the top three champions after their event.
- **Grades 7th-9th:** Group pictures will be taken immediately before their event, with individual pictures of the top three champions following their event.

- Each school is allowed up to two (2) alternates.
- Alternates may only compete if an original participant is unable to attend
- Alternates may only compete in the grade level for which they are designated as alternates.
